Special Meeting  
September 26, 2011

The special meeting of the Perry Village Council was called to order at 9:00AM with Mayor Laurence Logan presiding.

A special meeting was called by Mayor Logan to discuss repercussions and necessary cuts if levies on the November ballot do not pass.

A motion was made by Mr. Schultz and seconded by Mr. Young to go into executive session to discuss personnel compensation.

A motion was made by Mr. Cassella and seconded by Mr. Glover to go out of executive session.

DEPARTMENT HEADS:

Police – 1. Reduction of staff

2. Suspend K-9 program
3. Eliminate R.M.S.
4. Eliminate M.D.T. air cards
5. Return Rapid I.D.

Road – 1. Go to shift work for snow plowing to reduce overtime.

2. Reduce costs in other areas as much as possible.

OTHER:

L. Hofer - 1. Went over figures showing income and expenses with and without the passage of the levies.

P. Cassella – 1. Do we know when the most calls are received by police department? Would cut in R.M.S. reduce efficiency? (Absolutely)

2. Reductions:

- a. Recreation subsidy
- b. Hiring freeze
- c. Wage freeze
- d. Look into police district with Perry Township and possible North Perry
- f. Any additional revenue should first sustain personnel.

M. Glover – 1. Contract with Perry Township & possibly Leroy Township to provide police protection.


2. Cut miscellaneous council budget by 80%
3. Council agree to donate back 2 months of net apy.
4. Make road department a strict 2 man operation. No part time or contract workers for normal duties.


B. Shimko – 1. Park – have volunteers to maintain park. Community must be asked to help. (Who is going to co-ordinate volunteers.)

**CONSENSUS OF NECESSARY CUTS:**

1. Winter coverage – less salting, less snow plowing
2. No paving of streets
3. **Drastic** cuts to personnel
4. Elimination of 1-2 police cars
5. Possible eliminate plowing of sidewalks
6. Eliminate Tree City
7. Village Park – we recognize what an asset the park is to our village and will make all possible efforts to keep the park maintained and open as it is now.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Mr. Young and seconded by Ms. Shimko. The meeting adjourned at 10:47AM.
