Perry Village Council
Held at the Perry Village Hall

Regular Meeting
October 14, 2010

The regular meeting of the Perry Village Council was called to order at 7:00PM with Mayor Laurence Logan presiding.

A motion was made by Mr. Schultz and seconded by Mr. Young to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on September 9, 2010 as read. All members of Council present voted yes.

A motion was made by Mr. Schultz and seconded by Mr. Cassella to approve the minutes of the Special meeting held on September 23, 2010 as read. All members of Council present voted yes.

ORDINANCE 2010-07: Enacting Chapter 1321 of the Codified Ordinance of Perry, OH regarding the Demolition and Removal of Structures.

Introduced by Mr. Schultz and seconded by Mr. Glover.
Council members Cassella, Glover, Schultz, Stevens and Young voted yes.
Ms. Shimko was absent.

ORDINANCE 2010-08: Enacting Section 521.08.1 of the Codified Ordinance of Perry, OH establishing Rules and regulations pertaining to the collection of refuse and waste and Declaring an Emergency.

Introduced by Ms. Stevens and seconded by Mr. Young.
Council members Cassella, Glover, Stevens and Young voted yes.
Mr. Schultz voted no. Ms. Shimko was absent.

A motion was made by Mr. Young and seconded by Mr. Schultz to approve the Financial Report for the period ending August 31, 2010 as presented. All members of Council present voted yes.

A motion was made by Mr. Cassella and seconded by Mr. Glover to table to a time uncertain comprehensive storm water management.

A motion was made by Mr. Cassella and seconded by Mr. Young to contribute \$700 for the community Halloween Party. There was discussion as to whether this was something the village could continue to do in these fiscal times. Councilmen Cassella, Schultz and Young voted yes. Council members Glover and Stevens voted no.

A motion was made by Mr. Schultz and seconded by Mr. Glover to hold a Special Meeting on October 28, 2010 to further discuss the 2011 budget and any other business to come before council. All members of Council present voted yes.

4. Has comprehensive draft plan for sanitary sewer for east end of county done by C.T. Consultants. (Does not mean that sewers are going to be done anytime soon.)


5. Had a meeting with Oxbow Engineering on comprehensive storm water – there are real concerns with plan promoted by the state.

Budget Discussions:

1. Employees participate in hospitalization costs.
2. Reduction for recreation program to \$15,000
3. Mayor had salary cut by \$5,000
4. Cell phone usage?
5. Snow plowing of sidewalks – will be done as time is available.
6. Increase payroll tax rate to 1.5 or 2%.
