P. Cassella – Village awards program – Vicky, Michelle, Mayor and Phil (will need volunteers)

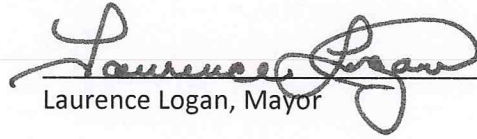
Mayor Logan – 1. Jason Boyd would like resolution on Balanced Growth Initiative.
