

RESOLUTION NO. 2011--21

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY PLACE A ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLAR (\$150,000) TAX LEVY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS TO PAY THE COSTS OF OPERATION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE PROVIDING OF POLICE PROTECTION FOR THE VILLAGE PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5705.19 AND 5705.191 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUE OF THE VILLAGE AND THE MILLAGE NECESSARY TO GENERATE SAID AMOUNT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council finds it to be in the best interest of the residents of the Village to take all steps necessary to place a **levy on the November 2011 ballot that will generate annual revenue in the amount of One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollar (\$150,000.00); and**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Division (B) of Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code, in order to submit the question of a tax levy pursuant to Sections 5705.19 and 5705.191 of the Revised Code, this Council must request that the Lake County Auditor certify (i) the total current tax valuation of the Village, and (ii) the millage necessary that would be generated by the subject levy; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Division (B) of Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code, upon receipt of a certified copy of a Resolution of this Council declaring the necessity of the tax, stating its purpose, whether it is an additional levy or a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax, and the Section of the Revised Code authorizing its submission to the Electors, and requesting such certification, the County Auditor is to certify the total current tax valuation of the Village **and the millage necessary to generate annual revenue in the amount of One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollar (\$150,000.00).**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Council declares that it is necessary to place a new levy, for a period of three (3) years, for the purpose of paying expenses **for the operation of the Village police department and the providing of police protection for the village and its residents**, and that it intends to submit the question of said levy to the Electors at an election to be held on November 8, 2011, as authorized by Sections 5705.19 and 5705.191 of the Revised Code.

Section 2. That Council requests the Auditor of Lake County, Ohio, to certify to be both (i) the total current tax valuation of the Village, and (ii) the millage necessary to be levied to generate **annual revenue in the amount of One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollar (\$150,000.00) for the purpose** specified in Section 1, *supra*.

Section 3. The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to promptly deliver a certified copy of this Resolution to the office of the Auditor of Lake County, Ohio.

Section 4. The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to request that notice of said election be given as provided by law.

Section 5. The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections of Lake County, Ohio.

Section 6. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were

adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its committees, which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 7. That all Resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 8 That this Resolution constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry and for further reason that the continued receipt of the proceeds of said levy is necessary to enable the Village to continue to provide essential Village services.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest possible date allowed by law.
