P. Cassella – 1. Road and Bridge is not part of General Fund
2. Putting on both income tax increase and Police & Fire Levy with a larger tax credit balances income across the board for all residents.

T. Hacking – Have we approached other communities on combined police department. (yes)

Mayor Logan – 1. Has been talking about Eastern Lake County Police Department to all east end officials


2. Handed out list of services that could be cut if no increase in revenue in the village.


Sean Moses – Police levy is the best value for the money.
