

RESOLUTION NO. 2011- 18

**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING AND URGING
OUR FEDERAL REPRESENTATIVE AND SENATORS
TO HALT ALL PLANS TO SIGNIFICANTLY CHANGE THE
OPERATIONS OF THE PERRY VILLAGE POSTAL SERVICE OFFICE**

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that the United States Postal Service has announced that it intends to significantly change its postal office services that has been located in and serving the residents of Perry Village, Ohio, for decades; and,

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that said changes, if allowed, would cause a serious decline in the level of service presently being provided the residents of our Village as well as create an unacceptable delay in the delivery time of postal items; and,


WHEREAS, Council finds that it would be in the best interest of the residents of the Village that said decision to significantly change the services of the "Perry Village Post Office" be rescinded.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY,
COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. That the Council of the Village of Perry hereby strongly requests, recommends and urges United States Senator Sherrod Brown, United States Senator Robert Portman and Congressman Steven C. LaTourette to take all steps, perform all acts, issue all orders and directives, and cast all votes necessary to the rescission of the planned changes to the level of service of the United States Postal Service office that has served the needs of the residents of Perry Village these one hundred and ninety two (192) years.

Section 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest possible date allowed by law.
